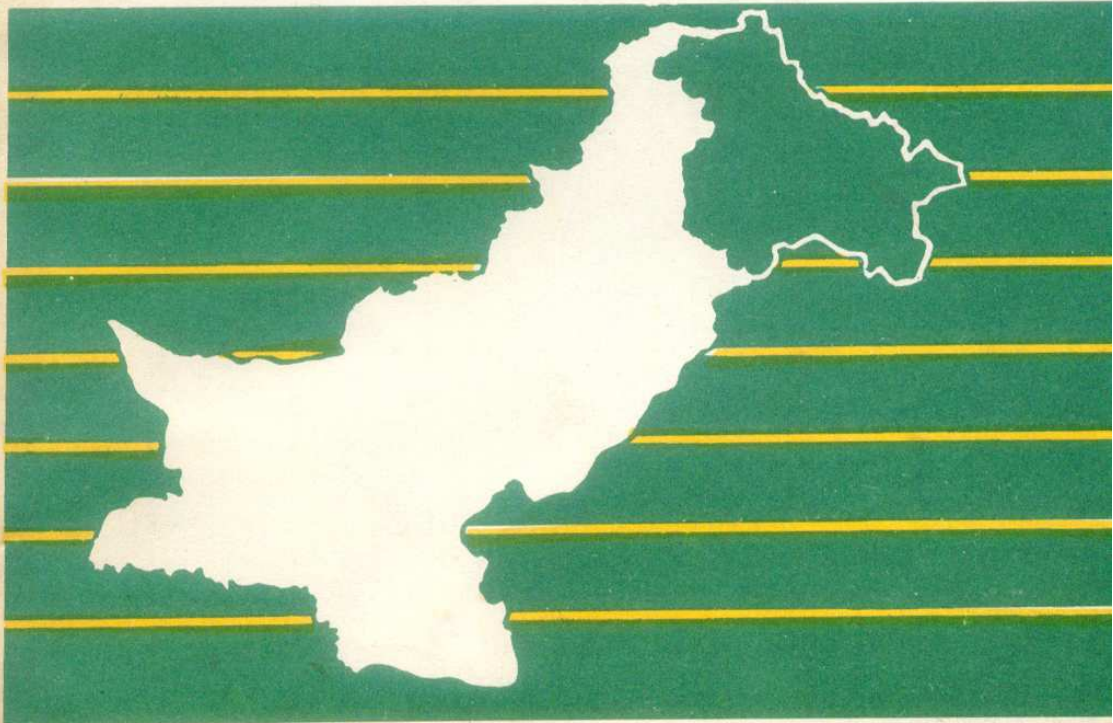

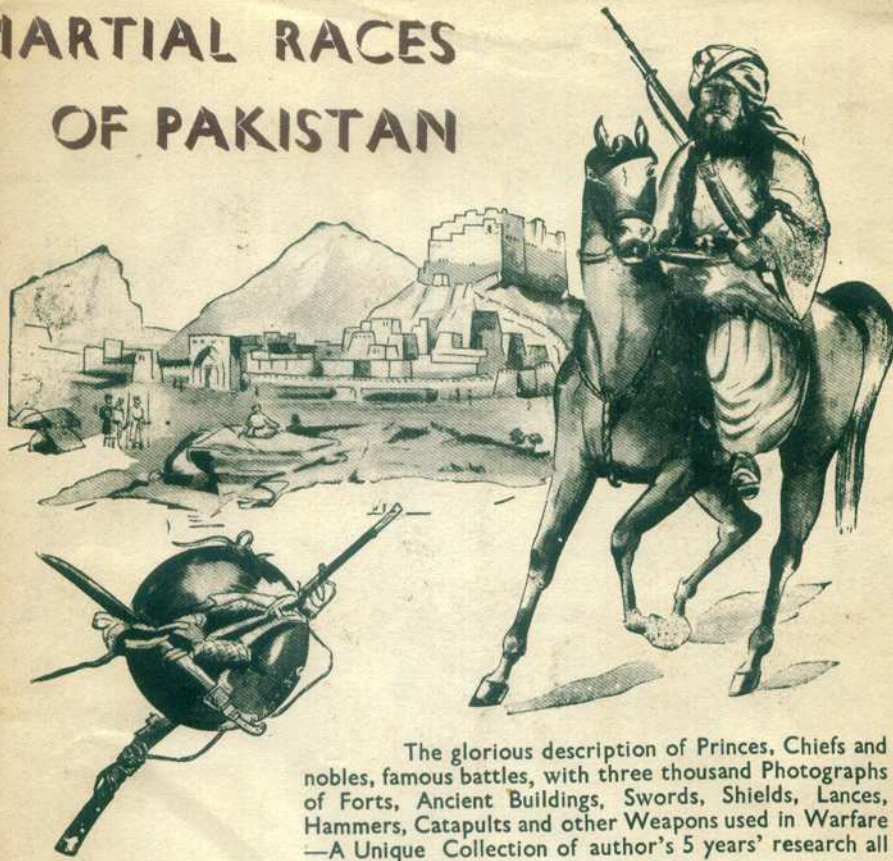

(Invitro); Dr. M.A. Soofi took active part in the political and social life of the country in his early days; participated in Pakistan Movement and lead a batch of volunteers to Azad Kashmir during the war of 1949; was the leader of provincial rally held at the grounds of Islamia College, Peshawar in honour of the then Governor General of Pakistan; has worked in the settlement of refugees and other relief work; won district first aid championship; was Director of the Dramatic Club, Quarter Master, Police Sergeant NWFP. UCTC. and Captain of the compulsory Military training in Islamia College, Peshawar; was prominent student leader and held the office of Joint Secretary, President of Dental Student Union LHP 1953-54, 55-56 respectively; was General Secretary Punjab Muslim Student Federation, General Secretary of Pakistan Science Student Federation; General Secretary Student Welfare Organization; President Constitutional making body World University Service, Secretary Punjab Muslim League National Guard; was a prominent debater in English and Urdu languages and was awarded merit colour for his social activities by the Student Union of Dental College Lahore; was Assistant Manager Dramatic Club in King Edward Medical College, Lahore 1953-54; was

posted at Sandeman Civil Hospital as dental Surgeon Quetta and Kalat Region, where he organized dental departments at modern lines; was President of Apex Club Quetta, Secretary of Clinical meeting of P.M.A. and Civil Hospital; was giving lectures to students of Amin-ud-Din Medical School; served at Civil Hospital Sibi and Ziarat and organized clinic on self help basis; served Mayo Hospital from August 1961 to August 1964 as incharge of dental clinic; transferred to Baluchistan in 1964 where he organized dental clinic at Sibi; proceeded to U.K. as British Council Scholar and attended the Post-Graduate course for one year at the Institute of Dental Surgery University of London; he worked in diseases of the gums under the guidance of World Known Periodontal Surgeon; was elected as a Member of British Society of Periodontology 1966; visited various Institutions of Great Britain like Guy's Hospital London, Dental School, Birmingham university and University of St. Andrew Dundee and Edinburgh; was posted in Mayo Hospital on his return where he renovated the dental department; was taken as Fellow of the International College of Dentists (FICD. USA); was transferred to Dental College, Lahore 1968, where he was teaching dental anatomy and clinical methods of conservation and Periodontology; during his stay in U.K. he presided several functions of national repute and was a speaker at Hyde Park Corner and has addressed Rotary, Li-

ons International Profession and Business Women Association and Churches; has addressed the Iranian Dental Association at Teheran to form RCD Dental Federation after meeting peoples at Turkey; was President of Pakistan Dental Association during 1968-70; is President of the same Association 1973-74; is active member of the Institute of International Affairs and is joint Secretary Public Health Association of Pakistan; President and Founder of Majlis-e-Yade Reftegan and Pak Muslim Ittehad Society; has been elected as Regent for Section 24 in Pakistan and Afghanistan by International College of Dentists; married to Dr. Iqbal Soofi, who is Assistant Professor Pharmacology King Edward Medical College, Lahore, in 1961; two sons and three daughters.
